## A Song for Everyone

People everywhere like to sing "Happy Birthday to You" at birthdays. The song is very simple, but it has an interesting history.

In 1893, in the United States, two school teachers wrote a song. They were the sisters Mildred and Patty Hill. The words were, "Good morning to you, Good morning to you, Good morning, dear children, Good morning to all". Teachers in many schools sang this song every day to their students. In 1911, people started singing this song at birthday parties, too. The music was the same, but the words were new. The Happy Birthday song was born.

Soon the song was in movies, on the radio and in the theater on Broadway. The Hill family wanted money for the song, so in 1934 they went to court. After that, these kinds of businesses paid money every time they used the Happy Birthday song. For example, Walt Disney paid \$5,000 to use it in a parade.

The Happy Birthday song became the most popular song in the world. The song is now translated into 18 languages, for example, Chinese, Korean and French. In 1988, a company called Warner Music became the owner of the song. Every year, it made a lot of money from the song. However, some people were not happy about this.

In 2010, one man said he wasn't sure whether the Hill sisters really wrote the music first. Three years later, a filmmaker made a movie about the song, but she didn't want to pay Warner Music. She went to court. In 2015, the court decided that Warner Music was wrong, and the song did not belong to the company. Now the song belongs to everyone.
