Save the Sea Turtle

Sea turtles have been swimming in our oceans for millions of years. However, in the last few decades, the number of sea turtles has fallen sharply. Pollution, unsustainable fishing and coastal development are major causes. Every year, thousands of turtles get injured or choke to death on the plastic in our oceans. Others drown in fishing nets. Turtle nesting sites are destroyed to make way for seaside hotels and marinas.

Turtles are important in Japanese culture. They often appear in traditional songs and legends. Turtle numbers were once protected by customary laws, as in the saying, “Mind not to gather all the eggs. Leave a few undisturbed to hatch.” Despite modern-day laws to protect the loggerhead, green and hawksbill turtles that nest on Japan’s shores, these species have become endangered.

Sea turtles spend much of their lives in the ocean. They have flippers instead of feet. Unlike the freshwater turtle, their flippers cannot go inside their shells.

Hatching is a dangerous stage in the life cycle of a sea turtle. During mating season, female turtles come ashore two or three times to lay eggs. Each female turtle buries about a hundred eggs in the sand each time. Many eggs are destroyed by weather and predatory animals. Of the baby turtles that hatch, few will survive the dangerous journey from sand to ocean. It is estimated that only one in a thousand hatchlings will reach the water.

Every year, large numbers of tourists visit beaches to see sea turtles lay their eggs and hatchlings hatch. For many people, it’s a ‘once-in-a-lifetime’ experience. In Japan, people can take turtle-watching tours in early summer and midsummer.

If you are planning to visit a nesting site, please remember the following.

- Turn off all lights when you enter the area.
- Move quietly and do not talk.
- Leave the turtles and nesting sites undisturbed.
- Take all litter with you when you leave.

We must make every effort to protect sea turtles and nesting beaches. With everyone’s help, the sea turtle will have a bright future.
