Heatwaves in India

Heatwaves in India have become more frequent, longer and more powerful, making it difficult for people to live comfortably.

Twelve of the country's warmest 15 years have been since 2006, with deaths from the heat increasing since the 1950s to over 3,000 people. Addressing such natural disasters, including heatwaves, requires a strong response by the Indian government.

Heatwaves occur when the Indian Plains area has temperatures over 40 degrees Celsius and the Indian Hills go over 30 degrees Celsius. These days usually occur in May and June, but they are now happening in March — with March 2022's heat wave (experienced by over 50 percent of Indian states) breaking 100-year-old records.

Heatwaves have a negative effect on people and cause *dehydration, exhaustion and heat-strokes. People in India who live in large cities and tall buildings have big problems because heat can make the buildings too hot to live in. People using air conditioning pay a lot of money for energy costs.

India is a country where two thirds of people live in poverty. Therefore, it is hard for many people to find places to stay when it's too hot outside. Old people often get sick because they can't find a place to cool off. Many schools in India do not have air conditioning. This makes the classrooms very hot, and it is difficult for students to focus and learn. Many times schools must close during a heatwave. This means students must stay home from school and miss a chance at education.

Farming is an important part of India's economy and culture. But heatwaves can cause problems for farmers. When there isn't much rain and a heatwave comes, many of the crops growing are destroyed. This causes a shortage of food for many areas. Prices for food also go up, which makes it hard for poorer people to buy food for them and their family.
